SERVICES

INFORMATION & REFERRALS

ProJeCt helps clients navigate and connect to community resources and provides information and case management as needed.

EMERGENCY SHELTER

While we do not operate a shelter, we may provide referrals to local shelters, or temporary hotel vouchers to qualified individuals and families.

EYE EXAMS & GLASSES

Individuals and families without vision insurance or the ability to obtain eye exams may qualify for one exam and one pair of glasses.



RENTAL ASSISTANCE

We may provide one month's rent to those who qualify. Applicants must provide documentation and demonstrate their ability to sustain housing once assistance has been provided.

UTILITY ASSISTANCE

Seniors age 60+ may qualify for assistance paying their home heating fuel bill. Limited metered utility assistance (includes gas, electricity, water, and sewer service) is also available for qualified individuals or households

FOOD PANTRY

ProJeCt operates the largest Full Choice Food Pantry in Northampton County. Clients may choose their own items and are assisted by trained volunteers and our Food Pantry Coordinator. Northampton County residents without the ability to purchase enough food may receive a 3-4 day supply of food once per month.
